## The Final Restoration Project

Two hundred years ago the Nellis family made the decision to build an addition at the east end of the homestead. You know it as the stencil room on the first floor and the family bedroom on the second floor (also stenciled).

Just off the bedroom is a much smaller room which may have served as a nursery for the youngest children. It has its own special pattern of stencils.

As the PSS trustees renovated and refurbished the rest of the building room by room over the past 40 years, this little room was left mostly untouched. The walls were included in the preparation for the stencil project, and the stencils were redone about 8 years ago. But it was still a bit sad looking.

Well, our good friend and general contractor came to the rescue. In the fall of 2023, Peter Elwood volunteered (at no charge) to repair the molding around the two windows and the door frame, and to rebuild the replacement door which had never fit properly. The original door had been removed "for safe keeping" years ago. He did the work in his spare time during the winter of 2024 and finished at the Tavern in the spring. Then his wife, Linda, volunteered to paint the woodwork and ceiling. The job was done in time for the 2024 Annual Rhubarb Festival. Although the floor remains to be painted the room is beautiful now and is furnished appropriately with items to be used by younger children.
